In addition to reading major literature illuminating changes in Arab culture and society, we will view film adaptations of some masterpieces of Arabic literary works that offer new perspectives about the lives and experiences of Arab writers.

Class discussions encompass Arab intellectualism and the modernization ideology, literature and war, patriarchy, sexuality, and religion.
