#### **Elementary French 1**

This course is designed for beginners of French and aims to develop students' listening, speaking, reading and writing skills in French. Students will learn French pronunciation, grammar and vocabulary in the context of important aspects of French culture.

Student learning is reinforced through videos with day-to-day interactions in France, interviews with native speakers and learners of French. Effective communication in French is promoted by having students use their knowledge of the language to interact with each other and with their teacher.

#### **Elementary French 2**

This course is designed to further develop students' language ability in French. The course continues to introduce students to the four language skills (i.e. speaking, writing, reading, and listening), fundamental grammar, as well as cultural facts of the Francophone world. An understanding of Francophone cultures is nourished through the examination of cultural practices and perspectives.
