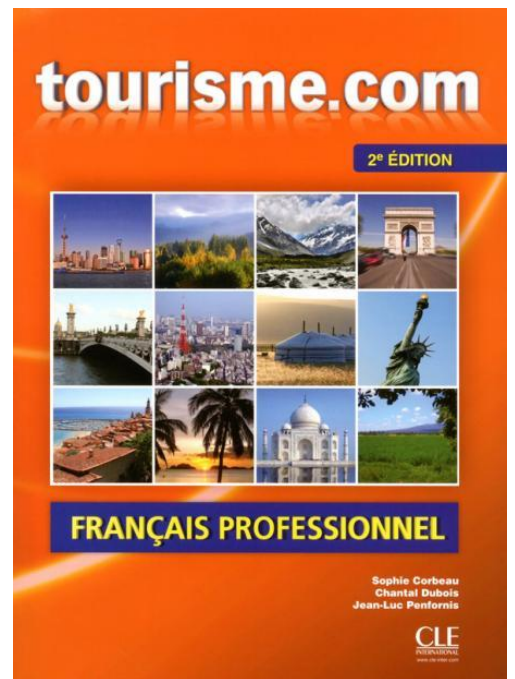
Would you like to:
